OUR RESULTS

Clinics may present their pregnancy rates in different ways which can be confusing and misleading. When looking at the success rates for a clinic, it's very important that you look at the figures carefully and ensure you look at those most relevant to your personal circumstances.

The majority of clinics perform around the national average (33%) and our clinical pregnancy rate for 2011 continues to match this rate across all age groups. Below we present the latest Clinical Pregnancy Rates:

MULTIPLE BIRTHS

Multiple pregnancies are the single biggest risk of fertility treatment to both mother and baby. Pre-eclampsia, gestational diabetes, miscarriage, premature birth of the baby and a reduced birth weight are some of the risks associated with a multiple pregnancy. Therefore the birth of a single, healthy child is the safest, most desirable outcome of fertility treatment.

All good prognosis patients are encouraged to have just one embryo transferred (Elective single embryo transfer) to minimise the risk associated with a multiple pregnancy. However self funded patients, who understand these risks, do have the option to have two embryos transferred.

The HFEA's target for 2011/12 is 85% of live births being made up of single babies. Our current singleton pregnancy rate for 2011 is 88.8%, which already exceeds this target.
