# Leicester Fertility Centre

As a fertility clinic we understand that embarking on fertility treatment is a significant decision, both emotionally and financially; for many it will be stressful and potentially costly.

Our price list reflects the requirements of the Competition and Markets Authority (CMA), the Advertising Standards Authority (ASA) and also the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (HFEA). It is designed to give you a clear overview of what is included within your care package at every stage of your journey with us, from initial investigations and treatments to any additional tests, giving you opportunity to financially plan for your care. Leicester Fertility Centre fees are reviewed annually, if the pricing structure changes a notice period if 30 days will apply.

- We accept most debit or credit cards. We are unable to take cash, cheque payments or American Express.
- The price and type of your consultation will be confirmed and payment taken at the time of booking, you will be emailed confirmation details following your payment.
- There is a charge for consultation appointments cancelled, by you, within 24 hours of the appointment time.
- Medication costs are not included in treatment prices. These are discussed and decided upon with your clinicians. Following your planning consultation the medication you need may change depending on how you respond during treatment. Additional costs will be added to your invoice.
- Your costed treatment plan will remain valid for a period of 60 days. If you do not start treatment within 60 days, you may be required to re-plan your treatment.
- All appointments, investigations, blood tests, medications and treatments must be paid for in advance. Non-payment of invoices may result in treatment delay or cancellation. Treatment cannot begin until the payment for treatment has been received in full.
- If you decide to withdraw from the treatment, no refund will be given for any medication, consultations, procedures, scans or blood tests already undertaken. Some treatments require that patients are registered with the HFEA. In the event of cancellation or halted treatment, HFEA fees, of £100 per patient for IVF, £40 per patient for DI, are non-refundable. See our refund policy and our terms and conditions in the event treatment is halted.
- Refunds are processed back onto the card you used to pay. Please allow 7 days for the refund to appear on your bank statement.

Your consultant may suggest one or more of the following tests to help determine if there are any identifiable underlying conditions why this may be happening to you. These tests are only carried out after a number of failed attempts and are not suitable for all patients.

### **Known Donor**



We support the LGBTQ+ communities and single females wishing to start a family. This treatment package enables an individual, who is not the partner of the commissioning patient/couple seeking treatment, to set up as a 'known donor'. This means that the egg or sperm obtained are solely for the use of the commissioning female/couple. Medication is an additional cost. These prices include;

- All nursing and lab appointments
- Viral screening
- Any monitoring scans for the donor
- Blood group, Haemoglobinopathy, Cytomegalovirus, CMV IgG and IgM, VDRL &Chlamydia
- Genetic screening Cystic Fibrosis screening & Karyotype
- Counselling
- Physical examination
- Egg collection including anaesthetic services and review

- Freezing and storage of up 2 sperm samples for use in treatment

## **Shared Motherhood**



This treatment allows for a female partner to create embryos using her own eggs, sharing them with her partner who will carry the pregnancy. Following your New Patient Initial consultation, which costs £210, and any investigations that are advised in that appointment, you will be ready to plan your journey. If you enroll with Access fertility, they will cover the fee for your egg collection and FET, they will not cover the cost for consultations, blood tests or donor sperm. The HFEA registration fees for both of you in included in the treatment price, however your medication is not, the prices include;

- All monitoring scans for both Donor and Carrier
- Counselling
- Donor investigations Hb & FBC, Cytomegalovirus CMV IgG and IgM
- Donor & Carrier Viral Screening
- Carrier Rubella, HB & FBC, Cytomegalovirus CMV IgG and IgM

# **Fertility Preservation**

Some patients may benefit cryopreservation (freezing) of their egg or sperm samples, prior to undergoing a medical procedure, or taking medication that may impact their future fertility. Others may benefit from the opportunity to cryopreserve samples for use at a later date, for personal or social reasons. We recommend visiting the HFEA website for additional advice and guidance. Medication costs are not included in these costs.

The prices for egg freezing includes;

- Egg collection including anaesthetic services and review
- Freezing of all mature egg(s) retrieved during collection
- Counselling
- All nurse appointments and scans
- All blood screening tests

The price for sperm freezing includes:

- Freezing of up to 2 semen samples within an agreed time period
