With that in mind, our price list has been developed in line with the requirements of the Competition and Markets Authority (CMA), the Advertising Standards Authority (ASA), and the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (HFEA). It is designed to provide you a clear and transparent overview of what is included in your care package at each stage of your journey with us — from initial investigations and treatments to any additional tests — helping you to plan financially for your care with confidence.

Leicester Fertility Centre reviews its fees annually. Should there be any changes to our pricing structure, a 30-day notice period will apply

- We accept most debit and credit cards. Please note that we do not accept cash, cheques, or Amex.
- The consultation type and cost will be confirmed at the time of booking, and payment will be taken immediately. A confirmation email will be sent the next day, following your payment.
- A cancellation fee applies if you cancel your consultation appointment within 24 hours of the scheduled time.
- Medication costs are not included in treatment prices. These will be discussed with your clinician and may change depending on your response during treatment. Any additional medication costs will be added to your invoice.
- Your personalised treatment plan is valid for 60 days. If treatment does not begin within this period, a new planning consultation may be required.
- All appointments, investigations, blood tests, medications, and treatments must be paid for in advance. Failure to pay may result in delays or cancellation of treatment. Treatment will only commence once full payment has been received.
- If you choose to withdraw from treatment, no refunds will be issued for any medication, consultations, procedures, scans, or blood tests already completed. For treatments requiring HFEA registration, the HFEA fees—£100 per patient for IVF and £40 per patient for DI—are non-refundable. Please refer to our refund policy and terms and conditions for further details.
- Refunds are issued to the original payment card. Please allow up to 7 days for the refund to appear on your bank statement.

Unfortunately not every embryo, even those which are top quality, will result in a positive pregnancy test or ongoing pregnancy. Your consultant may suggest one or more of the following tests to help determine if there are any identifiable underlying conditions why this may be happening to you. These tests are only carried out after a number of failed attempts and are not suitable for all patients.

## Insemination Treatment IUI & DI



This treatment may not be suitable for all our patients, advice will be given by your consultant. If your cycle is halted, you will need to pay for the ultrasound scans that you have had in that cycle. Donor Insemination costs include the HFEA fee, Medication is additional, the fee's include:

- Insemination with a clinical nurse specialist

## Known Donor

We support the LGBTQ+ communities and single females wishing to start a family. This treatment package enables an individual, who is not the partner of the commissioning patient/couple seeking treatment, to set up as a 'known donor'. This means that the egg or sperm obtained are solely for the use of the commissioning female/couple. Medication is an additional cost. These prices include;

- All nursing and lab appointments
- Viral screening
- Any monitoring scans for the donor
- Blood group, Haemoglobinopathy, Cytomegalovirus, CMV IgG and IgM, VDRL & Chlamydia
- Genetic screening Cystic Fibrosis screening & Karyotype
- Counselling
- Physical examination
- Egg collection including anaesthetic services and review
- HFEA fee(s)
- Freezing and storage of up to 2 sperm samples for use in treatment
- Storage of gametes for 3 years

## Shared Motherhood

This treatment allows for a female partner to create embryos using her own eggs, sharing them with her partner who will carry the pregnancy. Following your New Patient Initial consultation, which costs £210, and any investigations that are advised in that appointment, you will be ready to plan your journey. If you enroll with Access fertility, they will cover the fee for your egg collection and FET, they will not cover the cost for consultations, blood tests or donor sperm. The HFEA registration fees for both of you included in the treatment price, however your medication is not, the prices include;

- All monitoring scans for both Donor and Carrier
- Counselling
- Donor investigations Hb & FBC, Cytomegalovirus CMV IgG and IgM
- Donor & Carrier Viral Screening
- Carrier Rubella, HB & FBC, Cytomegalovirus CMV IgG and IgM
- Donor sperm, reduction of £670 if you outsource donor sperm.
- Donor Egg collection including anaesthetic service & review if required
- Carrier Embryo transfer with embryo glue
- Early pregnancy scan

You will be charged the current prices at the time you extend storage. There are no refunds for part storage periods or if the gametes have been used in treatment before the expiry period. Please see our refund policy for full details. The prices quoted are for storage only and do not cover the cost of usage or any additional test(s) or treatment. Samples can be stored for a maximum for 55 years, this is at the cost of the patient.

## Fertility Preservation

Depending on how you respond to medication during treatment, you may be required to pay for additional medication.



Some patients may benefit cryopreservation (freezing) of their egg or sperm samples, prior to undergoing a medical procedure, or taking medication that may impact their future fertility. Others may benefit from the opportunity to cryopreserve samples for use at a later date, for personal or social reasons. We recommend visiting the HFEA website for additional advice and guidance. Medication costs are not included in these costs.

Egg freezing includes;

- Egg collection including anaesthetic services and review
- Freezing of all mature egg(s) retrieved during collection
- Counselling
- All nurse appointments and scans
- All blood screening tests

Sperm freezing includes:

- Freezing of up to 2 semen samples within an agreed time period
- All blood screening tests
- Counselling
